FIRST WITNESS) DEFENCE

The accused, C-49968 - Pte. MURRAY HAMILTON FREEL, No. 9 District Depot, .A., being duly swom, is examined by the Defending Officer:

- Q. Pte. Freel, you were apprehended, if I might go back, at Quebec on the 1st day of September, 1945 - that is the charge on which you pleaded guilty a few minutes ago?
  - A. Yes, sir.
- Q. You were away from the 8th of August to the first day of September and you were apprehended on the 1st of September?
  - A. Yes, sir.
  - Q. Where were you held?
- I was taken to the Citadel. I was held there for a few days and then went to the hospital at Cove Field barracks .
  - Q. How long were you in hospital?
  - A. About a week and a half.
  - Q. And then where did they take you?
  - A. At No. 5 District Depot, Lauzon, Quebec.
  - And then what did you do?
- A. I went from Lauzon, Quebec, to Montreal Military Hospital .
- Q. Can you remember the approximate date when you left Lauzon?
  - A. Approximately the 14th or 15th of September, sir.
- Q. And did you go with leave to the Montreal Military Hospital?
  - A. No, sir.
  - Q. You went A. W. I. on about the 14th of September?
  - A. Am Yes, sir.
  - Q. And on the way you took sick?
