29. Liver, Syphilitic advanced.
30. Large gallstone removed post-mortem from gall bladder.
31. Inspissated bile removed from gall bladder post-mortem.
32. Pancreas from case of hæmorrhagic Pancreatitis,—Dr. Finley.
33. Abnormal forms of spleens. Two specimens.
34. Accessory spleens. Two specimens.
35. Horse-shoe shaped kidneys.
36. Hydronephrosis. Left kidney exhibiting very great distension from stoppage of the ureter by a calculus.
37. Hydronephrosis from same case exhibiting less distension, in pelvis blocked by a calculus.
38. Nine oxalic acid calculi of various sizes removed from last case.
