The order of the day, for the Houfe to refolve itfelf into a Committee of the whole Houfe, further to confider whether it fhall, in this Seffion, vote the neceffary fums for paying all the expences of the Civil Administration of the Government of this Province, being read;

The House accordingly resolved itself into the faid Committee.

Mr. Speaker left the Chair.

Mr. Gugy took the Chair of the Committee.

Mr. Speaker refumed the Chair;

And Mr. Gugy reported, that the Committee had come to feveral refolutions, which he was directed to lubmit to the Houle, whenever it fhould be pleafed to receive the fame.

ORDERED, that the report be received to-morrow.

The Houfe was moved, that the entry in the Journals of this Houfe, of the 14th day of April 1807, touching the advantages that would arife to this Province, from the appointment of an Agent refident in Great Britain, be now read.

The faid entry was read accordingly.

Upon motion of Mr. Borgia, leconded by Mr. Taschereau;

ORDERED, that Mr. Borgia have leave to bring in a Bill for appointing an Agent refident in the United Kingdom of Great-Britain and Ireland, for the purpole of attending to the interefts of this Province, when occasion may require it.

Then on motion of Mr. Robitaille, feconded by Mr. Garon;

The House adjourned.
