Stockholm, via London, Nov. 24.—
The 'Bagblad' in an article referring to the prospects of a crisis between Norway and Germany warns Norway against a "policy of adventure," declaring that Sweden is not prepared to follow Norway in such a policy to the danger of her own interests.
