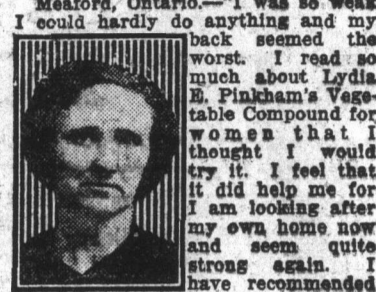

Use of Leech Revived. BLOOD SUCKING WORMS IMPORTED FROM TURKEY. London (By Canadian Press)—The use of the leech, the oldest of the old therapeutic measures, is being revived by physicians in the United Kingdom as a better method of relieving inflammatory areas. Not long ago it was said that the trade in leeches was one of the "dying trades." According to the "Hospitals and Health Review," there were in 1870 no fewer than a dozen merchants in Paris who made their living out of leeches, each of them selling between 200,000 and 400,000 leeches a month at 250 francs per thousand. Paris to-day has only one firm of the kind, and its sales are about 130,000 per month at 60 francs per thousand. The "Assistance Publique," which used to buy 20,000 francs' worth of leeches, now buys only 200 francs' worth. An authority of wide experience declared some days ago that there had been a "small boom" just recently, and that some chemists could easily dispose of double the number they are able to buy. This difficulty of supply is largely due to the fact that the old leech "farms" have disappeared. These farms had ponds into which old horses were made to walk at stated intervals in order to feed the "stock." Now leeches are fished for and exported in baskets from Turkey and other areas. Leech belongs to the blood-sucking class of insects, and its use probably more as a counter-irritant than as a remover of blood. It is a kind of animal of most peculiar structure, and its bite is not painful, and its action is not dangerous.
