

REPORTS FINAL EXAM RESULTS AT WESTERN 'U'

Dean W. Sherwood Fox Announces Record-Sized Graduating Classes.

QUALITY OF WORK HIGH

All War Time Students Complete Studies At London Institution.

Final examination results at Western University, which includes Medicine, Arts, Public Health, Assumption College, Sandwich, and Ursuline College (Brescia Hall) of this city, the latter two being affiliated Roman Catholic institutions, were announced for publication Friday.

According to Dean W. Sherwood Fox of Western University, the year 1922 "has been the most successful, scholastically, we have ever had."

This year's graduating classes are the largest that have ever been turned out, and next year, the dean states, the graduating classes will be greatly increased. With this year's classes, the last of the war-time classes, that is, those classes which entered while the war was still in progress.

The quality of the work of the students has been unusually high, the dean declared, and by far the largest percentage of students have achieved success in the examinations. Not all of the results from Assumption College are given below, but those not yet announced will be made public in all likelihood by Monday.
