


This buffalo at Springbank seems to be shunned by the remainder of the herd.



Rev. T. Walton, vicar at Lambeth, England, paints his own church owing to lack of funds. Parishioners assist him in their spare time.




Kettle Point, one of the most noted geological formations in Canada. This picture was taken when the water was unusually low.


