DAVID IN NEW YORK.

His Reception Last Night—Small Attendance—But a Determined Speech.

New York, June 19.—The audience at the academy of music tonight partaking in the reception of David, though not so large as the one which met Parnell, was equally enthusiastic.

The unexpectedly small attendance was attributed to the disapproval of the members of Irish nationality in the citizens committee to participate as a body in the reception, on the ground that they belonged to the right to receive the champion. David was loudly cheered on appearing. Judge Van Hosen presided and introduced the agitator in a laudatory address.

David recounted the charges which had been made against him, and said the whole of his life was to be used in the service of his people in the brotherhood of love. He could not be guilty of promoting disunion or contemplating a division of the league power when landlordinism is struggling against stratification at the hands of a united Ireland. He never had the idea of rivalry with Parnell, and he would never accept him (David) as leader, because he belonged to the ranks of the people. Parnell has all the qualifications of leadership, and he was content with being charged of promulgating a new doctrine of rivalry with Parnell.

David's friends, including the Rev. Dr. Barry, who had been invited to the meeting, were disappointed that a calm consideration of the question would dissipate the idea of the nationalization of the land of Ireland. The landowners of the neighborhood of the village of Kesh, who were the payment of taxes or in calling upon the government for the necessary funds for carrying out the necessary reforms. While I yield, he said, allegiance to the principle of Ireland's right to govern itself, I would not be a party to the destruction of the people and to keep down the promptings of revenge which are the peace, happiness and prosperity of Ireland.

Redmond then addressed the meeting after which a person in the audience offered for the Dublin assassin but was refused. Mr. Parnell made brief address, expressing confidence in David as long as he remained in the ranks of the people. Letters endorsing David and the cause were received from many prominent persons.

The Ottawa Conference.—Ottawa, June 19.—The preliminary trial (Timothy Sparrow, Angus Sparrow and James Sparrow) was continued today again this morning. Twenty witnesses were called. The testimony went to show that on different occasions when the Sparrow brothers had passed through the hands of the police, they had been treated with great cruelty. It was also shown that the Sparrow brothers had been kept in the private residence of a man named R. J. O'Connell, who had been a partner of steel rollers. It was not shown that R. J. O'Connell had actually attempted to pass any of the boys over his wall. The case was adjourned for a week.

The Progress of the United States.—London, June 19.—The Times says if there were no direct evidence of the reality of the rapidly the progress of the United States it would be a standing singular example of excitement in American politics. What is especially remarkable in the present development of American energy and success is its wide and equal representation. The readjustment of federal policy, the testimony to the real capacity of the people and efforts good hope for the future in the future may be rescued from the hands of the self-seeking professional philanthropists and the self-seeking demagogues.
