

MAY SOLVE PROBLEM

Winnipeg Engineer Has Invention by, Which Electricity Is Used for Heating Boiler

WINNIPEG, Oct. 5.-James Taylor, an engineer of this city, claims to be the inventor of a heating device that will heat a house for six cents per day. per room, or \$18 per month for a 10-room house.

At a recent demonstration of his Solicitors for The London and West-ern Trusts Company Limited, Adminis-trator. J6v-w Adminis-da nd expressed the opinion that the invention would revolutionize the heat-

ng problem of the city. Two devices were shown at the demonstration. One consisted of a gen-erator, or tank containing five tubes enclosing the special element which is the feature of the system. Water circulates around these producing which enters a boiler and is distribu through radiators.

"At the present rate this would be more expensive than coal," Mr. Taylor pointed out. "Before it could be used the power rates would have to come down. Prof. J. W. Dorsey, of the Manitoba University, has examined my system and is very much in favor of it. If the city would take his device for cheap transmission of power we could reduce the cost of electricity and enable citizens of Winnipeg to heat their homes by turning a switch, at less than the price of coal. This system means substituting electricity for coal to heat
