Lesibly many of our readers may not know that one form of worship recognized in India is intimidation—the use of threats, or even physical violence, to compel a reluctant deity te grant a boon. To call this by the name of worship is a fearful degradation of the id a; yet it is so designated, the same term (bhakti) being applied to this as well as to the highest kind of reverence. Poor India, when such is her worshin, and such are her gods! The orworship, and such are her gods! thodox Hindus regard this maining of their god as a most unhappy omen.
