

**Probable End Of the Canadian Rebellion.**

Riel is behind the bars; many of the rebels have surrendered their arms, and the general impression seems to be that the rebellion is virtually ended. But if the outlaw's words are true, his capture may only mean a suspension of hostilities. He claims that he is not the actual leader of the insurrection, but has only been an instrument in the hands of the prime movers, who sent for him while in Montana. A vigilante watch is still maintained on all sides and the search for Dumont is unceasing. Riel was captured on the 16th inst., four miles north of Batoche, by three scouts named Howrie, Armstrong and Diehl. He looks utterly demoralized and is constantly on the lookout for retribution from the soldiers or scouts. His eyes roll from side to side with the wild look of a hunted animal. He is very anxious to know what form his trial will take and begs that it may be by civil and not by martial law that he will be tried. This very question is perplexing the Canadian Government to such an extent that they find the outlaw quite as troublesome to dispose of when wholly within their power, as he was when scouring the plains with a myriad of followers under his command. - *The Chicago Journal of Commerce.*
