and would prove itself cheapest in the long run, by not recuiring painting or any: further outlay as regards up-kecp.

If you have not yet decided on your site I would strongly advise you to select the crown of a hill or a place where the ground slopes so that pools of water cannot form under the dwelling, or near by. If possible build so as to overlook an attractive view as this will greatly ald to the pleasure of your home.

Also pay a little attention to your garden. I have suggested a very simple idea in the plan reproduced herewith and one that would add considerable interest to the complete scheme. I would suggest planting the front with bright flowers as this is needed and if carried out properly would make, together with the colouring of the house, a very complete and successful effect.
