I have the honour to refer to your Note No. 223 of April 18, 1968, proposing an agreement between our two Governments to amend the arrangement relating to pre-sunrise operations of certain standard (AM) radio broadcasting stations. The amendment proposed in your Note is acceptable to the Government of Canada and I have the honour to confirm that your Note and this reply, which is authentic in French and in English, shall constitute an agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of America, effective from the date of this reply.
