

b. Certificates of Identity are not passports and do not entitle the holder to protection or assistance.

Refugee Travel Documents

15.10 Travel documents issued in the form approved by the Intergovernmental Committee on Refugees (Agreement of October 15th, 1946) are acceptable in lieu of passports for persons travelling to Canada either for permanent residence or for a visit.

In Transitu Certificates

15.11 a. In Transitu Certificates are required by the Department of National Revenue when goods bona fide exported to Canada from any country pass in transitu through another country in such a manner that any doubt might arise at the Canadian port of entry concerning the bona fides of the direct exportation.

b. The bill of lading for the transportation of the goods to Canada must show the ultimate destination of the goods from the place of original shipment to be a port in Canada, without any contingency of diversion, and the goods must not be entered for consumption or for warehouse or remain unclaimed or remain for any purpose other than their transshipment or transit in any intermediate country.

c. Upon application the Consul may issue in transity Certificates (see 22.30) provided he is satisfied that the provisions of b have been complied with.
