- E Canada will continue to collaborate with

 Great Britain and the United States with
 a view to the substantial coordination of
 their policies in relation to persons of
 Japanese racial origin within their respective
 jurisdictions.
- In accordance with these principles and in the execution of plans worked out well in advance, the Canadian Government, as a consequence of the new situation created by Japan's treacherous attack upon Pearl Harbour, at once immobilized all fishing vessels operated by persons of Japanese racial origin on the Pacific Coast. All persons of Japanese racial origin will be prohibited, for the duration of the war against Japan, from fishing or serving on fishing vessels; or on other vessels operated by Japanese off the Coast of British Columbia.
- 7. For the same period the sale of gasoline and explosives to persons of Japanese racial origin will be directly controlled under conditions to be prescribed by the Royal Canadian Lounted Police.
- 8. Japanese nationals will be forbidden to possess or use short-wave radio receiving sets, radio transmitters and cameras.
- Japanese nationals will be continued, and the Defence of Canada Regulations will be strictly enforced.
