DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENTS

The Honourable Jean Chrétien, Deputy Prime Minister and Secretary of State for External Affairs, announces the following diplomatic appointments:

Mr. Terence Charles Bacon (51) born in Princeton, British Columbia, as Ambassador to Czechoslovakia.

Mr. Bacon (LL.B., University of British Columbia, 1961) joined the Department of External Affairs in 1961. He has served in Accra, London and Brussels as well as taking part in the Bicultural Programme in Québec City. In 1979 he was named as High Commissioner to Zambia with concurrent accreditation to Malawi, Mozambique and, in 1980, to Zimbabwe. In 1981 he became Assistant Under-Secretary, Bureau of Legal Affairs and in 1983 was named to his present position as Director-General, Legal Affairs Bureau. Mr. Bacon will replace Mr. H. David Peel, who will return to Canada.
