PRAYERS.

Mr. Tolmie, from the Standing Committee on Justice and Legal Affairs, presented the Ninth Report of the said Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Monday, February 16, 1970, your Committee has considered Bill C-182, An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, and has agreed to report it without amendment.
