While I am on my feet, I would like to make note of the contrast between the definition of logging and the reference to off-highway which is followed by the definition of mining and the absence of any reference to off-highway. The two are inextricably entwined in a constituency such as mine.

Miss Nicholson (Trinity): Mr. Chairman, the February, 1984 Budget contained proposals for a formal assessment and appeal system to be introduced into the Excise Tax Act. We are now almost at the end of this Bill and at the section dealing with interest and penalties.

It seems that the Government has chosen not to proceed with those proposals, which were an effort to have the appeal rights of Canadian taxpayers protected and entrenched in law. I would appreciate an explanation of that.

Mrs. McDougall: Mr. Chairman, the Minister of Finance specifically indicated in the economic statement his intention to deal with the administration and appeals proposal at a later date. We would like to have some further consultations. Some private sector groups have expressed concern with certain aspects of the proposed system. The Government will be reviewing those concerns and we will bring them to the attention of the House at a later time.
