There are several fine salmon streams within a few hours' ride by rail of Fredericton. A few desirable streams are still unleased and may be secured at a reasonable rental from the Crown Land Department. Where the river is already leased it is not difficult for the visiting sportsman, in most cases, by application to local anglers, to obtain the right to fish.

With the possible exception of the Restigouche, the finest salmon river in the province is the Tobique. The angler may leave Andover in the morning by team, and hook his salmon for supper; or, by taking the railway to Plaster Rock, he can reduce this record by several hours. This beautiful mountain stream has been so well protected of recent years that the fish
