The better grades of hard wood are in good demand at firm prices: Whitewood is firm, with an excellent export demand taking care of the surplus. The quotations are: Quartered oak, \$75 to \$83; plain oak, \$45 to \$47; common and rejects, \$20.00 to \$25; red oak, plain, \$43; whitewood, \$54 to \$60; sap, \$43 to \$48; common, \$38 to 45; brown ash, \$41 to \$44; white ash, \$43 to \$46; maple, \$33 to \$37; end dried white map, \$46; birch, 75 per cent. red, \$40 to \$45; northern elm, \$29 to \$31; Michigan elm, \$34 to \$37.

Cedar shingles are quiet and easy: Extra cedar at \$3.40 to \$3.50; clear, \$2.90 to \$3.00; second clear, \$2.25 to \$2.40; extra No. 1, \$1.50 to \$1.75; British Columbia red cedar, 16-in. five butts to 2-in. \$3.50 to \$3.60; 18-in. five butts to 2 in. \$3.75; five butts to 2 1/2 in. \$3.90.

Laths are firm and unchanged: One and five-eighths in. \$3.25 to \$3.45; 1 1/2-in. \$3.10 to \$3.25.

The King Mercantile Co., of Cranbrook, B. C., is constructing a second sawmill on their limits, with a capacity of about 35,000 feet, giving a combined output for the two mills of 65,000 feet.

Two well-known Londoners, Messrs. J. Stevly and W. H. Braddon, have closed a deal for 6,000 acres of hickory timber land in northern Alabama, not far from Chattanooga, Tenn. There they will start a branch of the Columbia handle factory, which is located in London.

Advices from Port of Spain, Trinidad, up to 4th of July state: "Stocks of all descriptions are working down. Mixed cargoes of Canadian white pine and spruce would sell readily. The import duty is \$2 per thousand feet. There has been no cargo arrival of lumber for a fortnight. Nova Scotia white pine boards, No. 2 quality, were placed at \$19.25; Canada white pine boards, a lot was placed at \$28.
