PASSED BY CONVOCATION AT CALGARY, JANUARY 9TH AND 11TH, 1904.

The Attorney General or Solicitor General of Canada while occupying such position shall be entitled to practice in the Territorial Courts and be entitled to all the privileges of a member of the Territorial bar without enrollment or payment of any fees, provided such Attorney General or Solicitor General is a member of the bar of a Province which would admit under similar conditions an advocate of the Territories occupying the position of Attorney General or Solicitor General.

44c. Every application for enrollment as an advocate with all papers required for application of enrollment shall be sent by the Secretary immediately on his receiving the same to a Bencher residing in the Judicial District in which the applicant resides, who shall return the same to the Secretary with any observation he may wish to make on the same.
