pect with the greatest impatience, will enable us to fee farther into his dispositions. 'Tis to be believed, that if he thinks himfelf threatened, he will delay no longer firiking fome blows, and preventing those whom he stands in fear of, in order to avail himfelf of the fituation in which they shall be here, till the latter End of August, which is the time fixed for the total affembly of the troops, But on the other hand, if he remains quiet, he may be perfuaded, that he will be neither diffurbed or attacked, at least this year. However, from what Remarks I can make, I cannot help thinking, but that this court must be very certain of the friendship and attachment of Ruffia. This notion feems to me to be still confirmed, by a letter which the Dutch Minister at Petersburgh, M.Swart,

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has written, the 6th of this month, to M. de Burmannia, where, among other things, he mentions, that the French emiffary, the chevalier Douglas, gained ground daily.

As this cannot but produce in Ruffia an alteration of its antient fystem, it does not at all appear wonderful, that the high chancellor count Bestuchef, agreeable to what your excellency has done me the honour to write me word in your last dispatch, should have resolved on retiring into the country, on pretence of the recovery of his health, and
