RALLY IN WHEAT PRICES HELD A THE CLOSE

Chicago Market Ended the Day at a Fractional Loss — Sharp Recovery in Corn Fit the Feature — Oats Shade Higher.

CHICAGO, July 9.—A scare in the corn trade sprang up to-day over reports of extreme heat in Kansas, and brought about a lively advance in the market.

Aside from the flurry concerning possible damage by heat there was reason for more than usual interest regarding the government's first crop report this season as to corn.

It was not until corn had been sent 4-1/2c above last night that prices began to react when late advices from Kansas declared the crop in shape to report this season as to corn.

Commission house buying of wheat improved in volume to-day in consequence of the bulge in corn, and because there had been nearly a continuous week of declining prices.

Oats merely reflected the course of their cereals, with firmness the rule and in case of a sharp advance.

Receipts of wheat at northwest primary points, with usual comparisons, are as follows:

European Markets. The Liverpool market closed to-day unchanged to 3/4d lower than yesterday on wheat, and 1/4d lower to 3/4d higher on corn.

World's Visible Supplies. Breadstuffs figures show that during the past week there were visible supplies of wheat decreased \$3,025,000 bushels, corn decreased \$3,800,000 bushels, and oats decreased \$3,800,000 bushels.

European Visible. European visible wheat \$1,500,000, gains \$1,250,000 last week, decrease of \$2,500,000 bushels, and last year a decrease of \$3,800,000, when total was \$5,000,000 bushels.

SERIOUS DAMAGE DONE TO CROPS IN EUROPE

Broomhall Reports Unfavorable Weather Has Reduced Condition in Many Sections.

Broomhall's weekly summary of foreign crop conditions is as follows: United Kingdom.—Barley crops are ripening with favorable weather.

France.—There are many complaints heard that the unfavorable weather has caused serious damage, and at best the crop of wheat will not exceed last year.

Germany.—Oats of winter wheat are the prolonged rains and coldness has delayed ripening. Native supplies small, and demand for foreign wheat improving.

Hungary.—Harvesting results are variable, with indications of smaller yields than earlier expected.

Roumania.—Cutting is in full swing and the quality of wheat is showing poor, weighing 50 pounds to the bushel.

Austria.—In the Volga region, the largest producer of the crop is moderately fair with some patches of damaged crop.

Italy.—In the south yield is poor and elsewhere fair. Weather unfavorable, and this country is buying freely.

Spain.—Harvesting returns variable, and a crop about average is possible. The weather is not favorable for the new crop.

Argentina.—Further rains have fallen, and the general outlook is favorable. India.—Rains have not been general, and more is wanted.
