The Trustees have pleasure in stating that the duties of the Superintendent and Matron have been performed to their entire satisfaction by Mr. and Mrs. Perry.

A Committee meet every Monday, Wednesday and Friday during the winter, and on Tuesdays and Fridays during the summer, to consider all cases that may be brought before them; and prompt attention is always paid to any recommendation forwarded to them.

In conclusion, the Trustees look forward to an increased measure of support, this being a charity where all can unite in benefitting their less fortunate fellow-creatures. Want and misery are the only recommendations required; and no one, however prosperous to-day, can assure himself that his prosperity will continue—several of those who have been or are inmates of the institution having in more prosperous days contributed towards its funds, little expecting that they would require the assistance they afforded to others.
