

**CRUSADE FOR TEMPERANCE**

(Montreal Witness.)  
Most encouraging reports come from different country districts where the temperance crusade has been inaugurated. A correspondent writes to the *Sens* from Chamblay, stating that Rev. Fathers Edmund and Ladelle, Franciscans, closed a full week's temperance retreat in the parish recently, and all the church was crowded every day. The preachers found that in many instances they had to oppose cherished habits and customs, and wishing to secure serious and lasting results, they abstained from a general preaching, and left the question open for the consideration and free will of each individual. The result was that 220 heads of families and 160 young men, all people that may be relied upon, took the temperance cross, and the greatest confidence is placed in their example to emulate by influencing the rest of the parish.

One very pleasant feature was that among those who joined the temperance society were sixteen members of the municipal council out of a total of twenty-two councillors.

The Rev. Father Frederic, Franciscan, preached a temperance retreat to all the children of the parish of St. Laurent last week. Every family sent their boys and girls, who listened attentively to the sermons delivered, and were placed on the list of members of the temperance society. The temperance retreat for the men will be open on Monday next.

The crusade was also inaugurated in the parish of Repentigny last week. The Rev. Father Charles, Franciscan, who was the preacher, also recalled the duties of the lecturer and by means of illuminated views illustrated the evil effects of intemperance on the vital organs of the individual and on the welfare of the family. Very large congregations attended the meetings, and practically the whole population of the district joined the temperance society. After the closing exercises, all the bands of families present called on the Rev. Father to shake hands with him and thank him for the good work done.

A meeting of the executive of the Women's Missionary Society was held in the parlors of the Centenary church yesterday morning. Mrs. John D. Chipman, of St. Stephen, was in the chair. Plans for the district conventions of the society to be held in the maritime provinces during the week of a A. A. short session were discussed. A short address was given by T. B.
