The Board wish to recognize the services of the young men who have rendered considerable assistance in the temporal work of the church, in acting as ushers and looking after strangers generally who visit the church from time to time. In this way a good work has been done in the interest of the church, and we have no doubt the young men are benefited themselves according as they take interest in the good work.

The retiring Trustees at this time are Messrs. Charles Byrd, James Harper, A. E. Taylor and William Clelland, Jr., all of whom are eligible for re-election.
