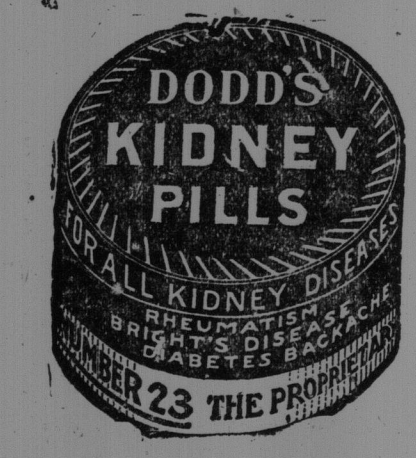

GERMANS DECIDE TO SEND ANOTHER NOTE TO ALLIES

New York, May 16—The Associated Press tonight issued the following:
Friday proved an off day in peace conference circles so far as the Council of Four was concerned. Premier Lloyd George was absent from Paris, bidding farewell to a Welsh regiment that left for home, while President Wilson devoted the day to visits by a number of delegations.
The negotiations with the Austrian peace delegation at St. Germain are expected to begin the middle of next week. The Austrians probably will present their credentials at a meeting of the peace congress on Tuesday, and it is reported unofficially that the following day may witness the handing of the peace terms to the delegation.

continuing its labors on the details of
the Austrian peace treaty connected with
the question of new frontiers. The
treaty, it is understood will not deal with
the disposition of Dalmatia, Istria or
Fiume, merely calling for Austrian re-
nunciation of rights to these territories.
The Italians and Jugo-Slavs, with
American mediation, will settle the ques-
tion of the former Austrian domain be-
tween themselves, if pending negotia-
tions reach a successful conclusion.

Another German Note.
Still another note from the German
peace plenipotentiaries to the Allied and
Associated Powers said to deal with
the question of Alsace-Lorraine, is in
course of preparation by the Germans.
The eventful day when the Turks are to
be reckoned with in a peace treaty is in-
dicated by the fact that British, French,
American, Italian and Greek warships,
with landing parties, have begun a great
concentration at Smyrna, Asia Minor.
Allied troops are also being massed at
Saloniki. The concentration at Smyrna
which it is thought probable will in-
clude a demand that the Turks leave
Europe.

The peace negotiations with Turkey
and also with Bulgaria are expected to
take place in Constantinople, Saloniki or
some other city in the Near East. The
Chinese cabinet is reported to have
tendered its resignation which Presi-
dent Hsu Shih Chang is said to have
declined to accept. The conference at
Shanghai which endeavors were
being made to arrange a peace between
northern and southern China has broken
up.
Vienna advises report that many per-
sons have been killed in clashes between
Serbs and Croats and Agrarians, capital
of Croatia.
