MICHIGAN'S FIRST TRIP OF SEASON WAS LONG, STORMY ONE

C. P. R. Liner in Port. 22 Days From Antwerp—Series of Gales

After a stormy passage of twenty-two days, the C. P. R. liner Lake Michigan, Captain Parry, steamed into port this morning and docked at Sand Point. The sides of the big liner were incased in ice and she had the appearance of having come through rough weather. Captain Parry said that almost continually from the time he left Antwerp, stormy weather was in order. High seas and strong head winds kept the liner back, and instead of making the voyage in ten or twelve days it took almost twice that time. Off the banks the weather was particularly bad, and the steamer was forced to steam along at a very slow speed. On entering the Bay of Fundy yesterday another storm was encountered, after which a heavy fog set in. The Michigan had about 4,000 tons of cargo and about 120 passengers. The liner was mostly all foreigners bound for western ports. This is the first trip of the Michigan to this port this season.
