\$2,000,000 BOND ISSUE

It was announced by the comptroller-general of the province that \$2,000,000 in bonds will be issued in December for the purpose of returning this amount of short term bonds due Dec. 1. Premier Foster said last evening that more than this amount was falling due but in what manner the government will place the issue on the market has not yet been decided.

According to H. C. Groulx general superintendent of the New Brunswick division of the C. P. R., who left yesterday for Montreal, a record passenger business both to and from European ports and heavy grain traffic is expected during the coming winter.
