

DEBOUCHERVILLE, *Hon. CHARLES EUGÈNE BOUCHER, M.D.* [*Montarville.*]

Descended from Lieut.-Gen. Pierre Boucher, Sieur de Grosbois, Governor of Three Rivers in 1653, and founder of the Seigniory of Boucherville. S. of the late Hon. Pierre Boucher de Boucherville, a mem. of the Leg. Council, Can., by Amelie, sister of the Hon. C. C. S. DeBleury. B. at Boucherville, P.Q., 1820. Ed. at St. Sulpice College, Montreal. Conducted his medical studies at Paris, where he graduated. M. 1st. Susane, [dau. of — Marrogh, Esq., advocate, of Montreal (dead). 2ndly. Miss C. Lussier, of Varennes. Sat for Chambly in L. A., Can., from g. e. 1861 until the Union. Appointed a mem. and Speaker of the Leg. Council, and a mem. of the Executive Council of Quebec, July, 1867.—*Boucherville; Quebec.*

DE LÉRY, *Hon. A. CHAUS.* [*Lauzon.*]

Descended from an ancient Can. family, of which the late Lieut.-Gen. Vicomte de Léry, of the French Engineers, was a mem. S. of the late Dr. de Léry, Clerk of the L. C., of Lower Canada. Appointed to the L. C., 1867.—*Ste. Marie de la Beauce, P.Q.*

DIONNE, *Hon. ELIZÉE.* [*Grandville.*]

Called to the L. C., 1867.—*Ste. Anne de la Pocatière, P.Q.*

DOSTALER, *Hon. PIERRE EUSTACHE, J.P.* [*De Lanaudière.*]

Sat for Berthier in L. A., Can., from g. e. 1854 to g. e. 1857, when defeated, and from g. e. 1861 to g. e. 1863, when again defeated. Appointed to the Leg. Council, P.Q., 1867.—*Berthier en haut, P.Q.*
