

An Act to amend the Act respecting the Coasting
Trade of Canada.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the
Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as
follows :—

1. Section 2 of the Act respecting the Coasting Trade of R.S.C., c. 83,
5 Canada, being chapter 83 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby new s. 2.
repealed and the following is substituted therefor :—

“2. No goods or passengers shall be carried by water, from Coasting
one port of Canada to another port of Canada, either for the trade to be in
whole voyage or for any part of the voyage, except in British British ships.

shall incur a penalty of four hundred dollars, and any goods Penalty for
so carried shall be forfeited, as smuggled, and such ship or contraven-

such penalty is paid, or security for the payment thereof is
given to his satisfaction, and until such goods are delivered
up to him, to be dealt with as goods forfeited under the pro-
visions of *The Customs Act*.
