An Act to repeal the Act respecting Petty Trespasses in Upper Canada.

WHEREAS the provisions of the Act hereinafter mentioned are incompatible with the well-being of society, inasmuch as they tolerate injustice and deprive Township Councils of the power vested in them by the Municipal Law, and it is expedient that the said Act be repealed; Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

Preamble.

1. From and after the passing of this Act, the Act intituled "An Act respecting Petty Trespasses in Upper Canada," being chapter one hundred and five of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, shall be repealed.
