Flying time 181.40 hours.</p> <p>Harvard II 2962 made a belly landing at the Main Aerodrome at about 0010 hours as a result of the pilot failing to lower the undercarriage. The pilot, R136963 LAC Murdock, J.B. was not injured. Categorized C.2.</p> <p>A Wings parade was held on the tarmac at approximately 1700 hours. 44 members of Course 76 of the Combined Training Establishment were presented with their Wings by Air Vice Marshal F.S.
