- The land asked for by the Indians adjoining Reserve No. 2 Page 2 and Porpoise Bay is covered by Lots 303 and 304 which are Crown granted. Both these lots were alienated before the the reserve was laid out in 1881.
- The land required adjacent to Reserve No. 1, is on Lots Page 12 1028 and 1356, both of which are covered by Crown grants.
- Proposed addition to Reserve is within Lot 1557, a Crown Page 13 Grant.
- The Indians ask for all the land between Reserves 8 and 9 Page 16 on both banks of the Tzoonye River a distance of 21 miles and about a mile wide. This is covered by Lot 2228, a TL.
- Boulder Island, about a mile south of Skookum Chuck, con-Page 17 tains about 15 acres. It is all rock with small fir trees upon it. It has not been alienated as it is very worthless.
- The Island in Porpoise Bay has been Crown Granted Lot 2634. Page 17
- With regard to Jeffreys claim about a mile north of Skookum Page 17 Chuck, I traversed the coast line from Lot 4094 (the nearest surveyed lot) to Jeffreys S.W. post and I found that by the official map the whole of his pre-emption, No. 292, as well of that of Mr. J. Silveys (Pre-emption No. 157) will be on Timber Limit 39643. Both these Pre-emptions depend on the eastern boundary of TL 39643, which has not been surveyed. Since my return I ascertained at the Land Office that a surveyor is now surveying both the Timber Limit and the two pre-emptions and also connecting with Lot 4094. Up' his notes are in it is impossible to say on whose la Indian village is.
