

Squamish Indian Reserve,

May 6th 1946, 19

We, the undersigned, Chief and Councillors of the Squamish Band of Indians owning the Reserve situated at North Vancouver, in the Vancouver Indian Agency, in the Province of B. C. at a council summoned for the purpose, according to the rules of the Band, and held on the said Reserve, this 6th day of May, A.D. 1946, in the presence of the Indian Agent for the said Reserve, representing thereat the Minister of Mines and Resources for the Dominion of Canada;

Do hereby for ourselves, and on behalf of the Indian owners of the said Reserve, ~~request that a sum not exceeding~~ request that a permit be issued for ~~Dollars, be paid out of money standing to the credit of this Band, for the purpose of~~ cutting timber on Squamish I. R. No. 15 (Alkwucks) up to 150,000 f.b.m. this timber being cut by Charlie Antone and Joe Moody, in addition to the 50,000 f.b.m. already authorized to be cut by Moses Billy on this Reserve, making 200,000 f.b.m. in all; the stumpage on this to be \$ 2.00 per thousand.
