HOMESTEAD

REGULATIONS

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Maultoba or the Morthwest Territories, excepting 8 and 28, which has not been homesceaded, or reserved to provide wood lots for settlers, or for other purposes, may be homesteaded upon by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-cuarter section of 160 acres, more or less.

ENTRY.

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the District in which the land to be taken is

ettuate, or if the homesteader de-sires he may, on application to the Minister of the Interior, Ottawa, the Commissioner of Immigration, Wincipeg, or the Local Agent for the District in which the land is situate, receive authority for some one to make entry for him. A fee \$10 is charged for a homestead
