An Act in Addition to, and Amendment of, and for further prolonging, an Act made and passed in the First Year of His Majesty's Reign, intitled An Act for suppressing unlicensed Houses, and for granting to His Majesty a Duty on Persons hereafter to be licensed.

HERE 15 notwithstanding the Penalties in the Bot the Ast made with and passed in the Field Xear of His Mujesty's Reign, intitled, Ass, Act for suppressing unlicensed Houses, and for granting to His Mujesty a Duty on Persons hereaster to be licensed, diversible and sll disso so Persons do continue to keep private Tippling Houses, to the great Encouragement of Vice and Debauchery, and the Diminution of His Majesty's Revenue.

Jemp.

That from and after the Publication of this Act, the Collector or Receiver, or Collectors or Receivers of the Duties of Impost and Excise, or either of them shall be and are hereby impowered and required, to make diligent Enquiry after and prosecute any Person or Persons, who shall presume to retail any Kind of Spirituous Liquors contrary to the Intent and Meaning of the Act made and pussed in the First Year of His Majesty's Reign, intitled An Act for suppressing unlicensed Houses, and for granting to His Majesty a Duty on Persons bereafter to be licensed, or that shall offend in any of the Particulars therein contained.

And whereas amongst other Things in the aforesaid Act, it is enacted, "That all Monies arising from the Conviction of any Person or Persons atoresaid (in Case there be no Informer) shall be wholly paid to the Treafurer of the Province, and applied in the Manner as therein after directed, but if there shall be an Informer, one Mojety of such Money shall be paid to the said Informer, and the other Mosety to the said Treasurer forthwithto be applied as aforesaid." It is thought necessary for the better Encouragement of Persons informing against such as may transgress against any of the Clauses in the aforesaid Act.

Be it therefore enabled, That all the Monies arising from the Conviction of any Person of Persons for the Breach of any Part of said Act, shall after deducting the Charges of Profecution, be paid two Thirds to the
