The largest insurance paid was on the life of Thos. L. Shevlin, Minneapolis for \$1.525,000. the largest in Corada was R. M. Thompson, Winnipeg, \$117,000 and the largest in Nova Scotia on Bowman B. Law, M. P., Yarmouth, who perished in the House of Parliament fire at Ottawa \$91,500. Payments in leading cities were: In United States, New York, \$37,531,000; In Canada, Montreal, \$2,650,000; In Nova Scotia, Halifax, \$181,000, with Yarmouth following with \$120,000.
