LIBRARY SITE PROBLEM.

At the City Council meeting last evening, the matter of the selection of a Library site was referred back to the Library Board committee for further consideration.

If the reconsideration results in the abandonment of the Martin property for the purpose, The Planet believes it will be fortunate.

Nor do we believe that the McDonald property, on the corner of Cross and Queen Sts., would be an ideal selection.

While The Planet is still earnest in its opinion that the choice of the King St. West site would be in the best interests of the whole city, yet it desires to be arbitrary in its convictions.

For example, it strikes us that the Knight property, corner of Victoria Ave. and Dover Sts., is worthy of more than passing consideration.

Then, again, if it could be secured, the McLaren property on the corner of Park and William Sts., would be a pretty and not inconvenient location.

The objection here, however, would have less force.

OUTLOOK FOR LABOR.

The honor, however, has been the only inducement, for the salary attached to the office is not only far less than the income which any good lawyer makes, but is so small as to be a positive bar to the acceptance of the position.
