MISSING ISSUES:

Almost every year is missing one or more issues, or parts of issues, owing mainly to wear at the beginning and end of the bound volumes.

An entire year is missing, from February 1918 to March 1919, at which point it appears a year in the volume numbering may have been duplicated. Volume 29, no 49, Whole Number 1500 [Feb. 7, 1918] is followed by Volume 30, no. 4, Whole Number 1555 [March 20, 1919]. The list of missing numbers is as follows:
