

AUDITOR-GENERAL

MAY STEP ON

Says He Will Resign Unless Audit Act Be Amended as Requested.

Ottawa, May 8.—The Auditor-General, Mr. J. Lorne McDougall, has submitted another report to Parliament reiterating his desire to have the audit act amended. It is impossible for him to remain, he states, unless the law is amended in many important particulars.

he desires to know at the earliest possible moment whether the representatives of the people agree with the policy and the action of the majority and they will leave without annuities or without. The Auditor General renews his appeal for the appointment of a special committee to investigate the matter, to make a report, and see whether there is ground for his complaint.
