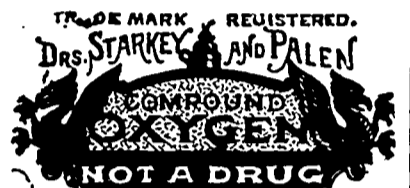

WHEN the rubber rollers of your wringer become sticky, as they very often do after wringing flannels, rub with kerosene and wipe dry, and they will be nice and smooth.

HORSE-RADISH cut in thin strips lengthwise, and a dozen or more of these strips placed on the top of each keg of pickles, will keep them from becoming stale or mouldy.

To prevent mould from forming on jelly, before putting on the cover cut a piece of paper the size of the inside of the glass, rub it over with white of egg, and lay it on the jelly.

SCALLOPED MUTTON.—Cut the cold mutton into small thin pieces, removing all the fat and gristle. Put a layer of bread crumbs in the bottom of a shallow baking dish, then a layer of meat, a very thin layer of crumbs, then gravy. Alternate these layers until the dish is full, spread buttered crumbs on the top and bake until the crumbs are brown.

ASPARAGUS REAS—Cut into small equal pieces the tender part of asparagus, wash in several waters, and throw into boiling water slightly salted. When nearly done drain through a sieve and dry on a towel, then place them in a stew-pan, with a bit of butter, a bunch of parsley, and two or three small onions, and toss over the fire for about ten minutes, then remove the parsley and onions, add a lump of sugar, a little boiling water, and a little flour; thicken with the yolks of two eggs beaten with a little cream and a little salt.
