For some months past it has been apparent that there was a considerable and growing sentiment among members of our several Staffs throughout Canada, in favor of the whole organization joining together in the support of some worthy patriotic object. It has been felt that within our own ranks there was a potential factor to be helpful, that should be organized in the interests of the Empire, and also in the interests of the individuals connected with our own and affiliated Companies.

In order that this increasing sentiment might take on practical form, the Directors of the Company have been considering, for some months, the advisability and possibility of establishing and maintaining a Convalescent Home in England, primarily for Canadian Soldiers, the equipment and support of which would be provided to a limited extent by the Company, but chiefly by voluntary contributions from its Directors, Shareholders, and the Office, Factory and Sales Staffs in Canada.
