assistance to the Soviet Union and we stand by that. We'd like to see that happen.

The...I gather that, I mean our people are in Moscow for the debt discussions right now. I haven't had a brief in the last two hours but I think there was something breaking on the news about what came out of that today. But we've been very active. We've had people in Moscow almost continually. Some of our senior finance people have been there almost continually over the last couple of months.

So we will do our share and we will urge that more be done where necessary. The difficulty is agin that we don't want to see this done at the expense of the poorest countries, so taht we intend to keep up our aid to Africa and to other countries. But most particularly Africa which is of central concern to Canada.

Q: You're something of a rarity, a female foreign

Minister and probably the first in Canada if I'm not

mistaken.

MCDOUGALL: Second, Flora MacDonald, both Conservative...

Q: Who?

MCDOUGALL: Joe Clark, Flora MacDonald was under Joe Clark.

Q: That's right, oh that's right.

MCDOUGALL: It's always Conservatives that promote women.
