The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Howard Green, announced today the appointment of Mr. George Roscoe Paterson, Director of the Agriculture and Fisheries Branch of the Department of Trade and Commerce, as Consul General in Los Angeles, California, U.S.A.

It is expected that Mr. Paterson will take up his new duties shortly.

Mr. Paterson was born in Scarborough, Ontario, on November 26, 1898. He is a graduate from the University of Toronto where he obtained a Bachelor of Science degree in Agriculture. He is also a Master of Science from Iowa State College. Mr. Paterson has been with the Department of Trade and Commerce for some 21 years. During this time he served in London and Washington and on many International and Interdepartmental committees.

Mr. Paterson served in World War I with the Canadian Army and the R.A.F.

Mr. Paterson is married.
