 to have described it during an interview given
 by him in London in 1919 "as one of the

 would be so much better for the Historian's purpose.
 I hope you will forgive me
 mentioning this and my assistance will be
 gratefully received.

The doctor will not let me travel
 yet but for some time but my pension will
 do on for a further period whilst the wound
 is better. Please give my kind regards to Lady
 Currie and my friends in Montreal who may care
 to hear about me. I do wish I was able to be
 at Montreal on the 11th inst. you must have had
