A P R O C L A M A T I O N.

“ WHEREAS I am informed, that many of
 his Majesty's deluded subjects of the neigh-
 bouring provinces, labouring under wounds
 and diverse disorders, are dispersed in the ad-
 jacent woods and parishes, and are in great
 danger of perishing for want of proper assist-
 ance. All captains, and other officers of mi-
 litia, are hereby commanded to make dili-
 gent search for all such distressed persons, and
 afford them all necessary relief, and convey
 them to the general hospital, where proper
 care shall be taken of them. All reasonable
 expences which may be incurred in complying
 with this order, shall be repaid by the receiver-
 general.
