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1. Explain the meaning of:—sensation, percept, concept, representation, philosophic imagination.
  2. Describe how you would:—
    - (a) secure and retain attention,
    - (b) cultivate the memory
  3. What is meant by Consciousness? State its office. Name its characteristics and explain each.
  4. Compare the Inductive and Deductive systems of "Reasoning," and illustrate each by example. Show the method of applying each to any subject taken up in the school work.
  5. State how you would develop (a) the æsthetic, (b) the moral sentiment in the minds of the young.
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1. (a) Mention at least three things that you will consciously do in your school work because of your study of Psychology. Give your reasons for heeding these.  
(b) Mention at least three things you will avoid doing in school. State your psychological reasons for this avoidance.
  2. (a) Explain the term "Concept."  
(b) Illustrate your explanation by showing how a child obtains a concept of tree and of pine tree.
  3. (a) What is habit?  
(b) Explain how we are so constituted as to be enabled to form habits.  
(c) Show that habit aids and also hinders good work in school.
