**JUSTICE OSLEK'S LETTER.**  
His Lordship thought it was necessary to write C. A. Farewell in the Ontario Case.  
Mr. Justice Osler was spoken to by the World yesterday in reference to the letter he sent to Crown-Attorney Farewell of Whitby, relating to the punishment of crooks, who operated in the South Ontario by-election. His Lordship said he thought it improper for a Judge to discuss such matters with the press, and he thought the Crown-Attorney was the person to be sought for such information. Asked as to the contents of the letter, His Lordship said he had sent no copy of it, but that it was merely formal, reporting the names of persons who had been guilty of corrupt and illegal practices in connection with the election.  
"Was it just such a letter as it is customary for a Judge to send a Crown-Attorney after such an election?" he was asked.  
"I don't know that it is customary, but I think it was necessary in this case," replied His Lordship, who declined to further discuss the matter.

**RIGHTS OF THE FINNS.**  
His Imperial Majesty the Czar Will Adhere to the Work of His Forefathers.  
St. Petersburg, July 4.—While refusing to receive the Finnish deputations, the Czar has issued a rescript declaring that when he ascended the throne he took up the sacred duty of watching over the welfare of all the people under the Russian crown and deemed it well to preserve to Finland the special rights of internal legislation conferred on it by his mighty forefathers. His Majesty then expressed the hope that the loyal devotion of the Finns would prove to the satisfaction of the Governor-General.

**TORONTO PRESBYTERY.**  
Rev. Mr. Hossack Released From His Pastorate—Rev. John McNeill's Call to Oakville.  
At the meeting of Toronto Presbytery yesterday Rev. D. C. Hossack of Parkdale Presbyterian Church formally asked to be released. There were present members of the session and of the Board of Management, who spoke in the highest terms of Mr. Hossack, and regretted that his health did not permit him to retain his pastorate. His resignation was accepted, to take effect July 16.  
Rev. J. McP. Scott was re-elected moderator.  
Rev. John McNeill of Waterloo will be inducted into the pastorate of Oakville, July 18. The moderator will be Rev. A. H. McMillan; Rev. J. McP. Scott will preach; Rev. Principal Caven will address the minister; and Rev. John Neil will address the congregation.

**Higher Than 85 Years' Average.**  
The weather report for June, issued by the Meteorological Department, shows that the mean temperature was 66.0 degrees, being 8.5 degrees higher than the average of 58 years, and 0.6 degrees higher than June, 1908. The highest temperature, 88.0 degrees, occurred on the 22nd, and the lowest, 44.2 degrees, on the 11th. The warmest day was the 6th, mean temperature 74.8 degrees, and the coldest day, the 10th, mean temperature 57.28 degrees.

**Sacrament of Confirmation.**  
Archbishop O'Connor, accompanied by Rev. Dr. Tracy, yesterday administered the sacrament of confirmation to a number of the young people of Dixie and Fort Credit. Rev. Father Coyte, parish priest, assisted in the service.

# DAMAGES MUST BE COUNTED

When Total Cost of the Proposed Enlargement of St. James' Cemetery is Figured.

**ARE WORKING FOR A PRECEDENT**  
In the Proposed Appointment of McRae as Chief Engineer at the Pumping Station.

It is understood that the Rosedallites with property in the vicinity of the Hoskin lot, with which it is proposed to enlarge St. James' Cemetery, are advised that they would have a good case for damages against the city. They would base claims on the fact that the sentimental terror with which some people regard cemeteries would depreciate their property. Ald. Crane thinks that those who are booming the cemetery deal should count damages as among the other costs which the city would have to under.

**Are They Ateer a Precedent?**  
It is commonly stated at City Hall that the appointment of Alex. McRae to the vacant chieftaincy of the main pumping station, if it is effected, is to be used as a precedent. Some time in the future there must be a vacancy at the head of the City Clerk's Department. McRae is an outsider and Controller Burns hinted yesterday that it might be convenient to refer to his appointment as a precedent, when an attempt is made to put an outsider in as City Clerk and to suspend the rule of promotion.

**No, No, It Can't Be.**  
It is possible that the rumor is true that the Ald. Hallam will present the city with a set of claims for the new City Hall. He would not deny that he would yesterday. It would be a clever feat to float on the wave of popularity which would sweep into the Mayorality, either by a coup or by election.

**Victoria-Street Extension.**  
To-day three committees will meet, the Board of Works, the Board of Health and the Parks and Exhibitions Committee. The first will discuss a report to be forthcoming from the Assessment Commission and City Engineer, making what they believe to be a judicious and equitable apportionment of the cost of extending Victoria street to Colborne street. There appears to be a growing feeling that the extension of local ratepayers should be extremely light and it is not improbable that the report will come in in that way. Some difficulty has also been experienced in determining what neighboring properties would be benefited by the extension of the street. The Assessment Commission, however, will be asked to make an estimate of benefit that would cover a large territory.

**The Award of the Appraisers.**  
The Parks and Exhibitions Committee are to have before them alternative plans for a brick or frame new Machinery Hall, with estimates of respective cost. According to the report of the two appraisers, the brick hall, the architect-to-be, having acted for the city, the full insurance, \$8,000, will be paid for Machinery Hall itself. The loss was \$17,000. For the boilers, engine and shafting the city is awarded \$271,750. A total policy of \$280,000 of the above appraisals being again of utility. For damages to agricultural implements \$18,000 is awarded, and for those to the fences and gates \$180, making a total award of \$1,022,750.

**A New Pest House.**  
The Board of Health will have before it the regular report of M. G. O'Rourke, who announces that either of the sites chosen by a sub-committee for a new smallpox hospital, being park property, could not be used without the consent of the Legislature. Dr. Sinden's view is that the pest house could be erected in the rear of, but isolated from, the hospital, the new wing to the hospital, accessible to new side residents only.

**City's Health Good.**  
"I am pleased," adds the Health Officer, "to be able to state that the sanitary condition of the city is highly satisfactory. The number of cases of epidemic diseases reported for June, 1908, 8; Diptheria, 4; scarlet fever, 28; typhoid, 6; and diphtheria, 15 and respectively last year. The Board of Control will not meet until Friday."
