The Committee have the satisfaction of retires along the satisfaction of retires.

The Committee have the satisfaction of noting a large increase in the return of 1870 for general purposes, from the following places:—Albion Mines, Amherst (being \$54 more than in 1869), Annapolis, Antigonishe, Dartmouth (40.76 more than in 1869), Glace Bay, from which there was no return in 1869, has sent \$104. St. Paul's, Halifax, \$82.44 more than last year, and St. George's \$31.75 more than in 1869. St. Luke's has still further increased its contribution by \$234.53. Liverpool has sent \$30 more than last year. River John, \$11.25 more. Ship Harbor, \$21.67 in advance. Sydney, \$19 more, and from Louisburg (whence no return was sent last year) \$53.

The Committee cannot but regret to notice that the returns have not been made from several places which contributed last year.
